

TERMS & CONDITIONS

VENUE: Expo Site, Orchid Beach, Fraser Island

EXPO DATES: Saturday 16th May to Friday 22nd May 2009.

OFFICIAL OPENING: 6pm Saturday

DATE/TIME OF FISHING COMPETITION: Midnight Saturday to 1pm Friday

The information on how to enter the Fishing Competition, and the Random and Major Prize Promotional Games, form part of the conditions of entry. **COMPETITOR ENTRY:** \$230 (GST inclusive) per person. Toyota owners entering the competition and who can verify current ownership of any Toyota vehicle (Toyota, Lexus, Daihatsu or Hino) by attaching a copy of their current registration renewal certificate to their entry form will benefit by receiving a Toyota Family, "Customer Loyalty Subsidy" of \$25 (GST inclusive) per entry. The reduced Toyota Family entry fee is \$205 (GST inclusive) per person. The Toyota owner's Customer Loyalty Subsidy is also available to the spouse of the Toyota owner competitor, provided the spouse lives at the same address. No other family members are entitled to the reduced fee.

Competitors must complete the application form and include two passport size photographs with their application. Application forms not correctly filled out will render that entry ineligible. Entries received after 6.00am on Sunday will not be eligible to weigh-in a fish for 40 hours from the time the Entry is accepted and processed. Entries unless sold out will be accepted up to 4pm on the Wednesday after the Official Opening. The competition is limited to 1500 Competitors. A person will only be eligible to enter the competition once under one entry number and one name and must be at least 17 years of age on Friday 15th May, 2009.

TMCA may use any personal information, including photographs taken during the competition, entrants (Competitors or Associates) provide in connection with this competition or future competitions for the purpose of running the competition or future competitions, and also in advertisements, publications, media statements and other promotional material associated with the competition or future competitions. TMCA may disclose the information for those purposes to its related bodies corporate and contractors, and to Toyota dealers. If entrants do not provide the information requested they will not be able to enter the competition.

IDENTIFICATION: Competitors will be issued with an Official Pass (Photographic Identification Pass), which must be displayed to gain entry to the weigh-in and entertainment areas. This Official Pass must be produced to Toyota Motor Corporation Australia Limited ABN 64 009 686 097 (TMCA) representative before collecting on stage any prize of any nature. Reference should be made to the Terms and Conditions of the Random & Major Prize Promotional Games section of these Program & Conditions. Anyone without an Official Pass will be denied access to these areas unless under 17 years of age and accompanied by an adult with an Official or Associate Pass (described below). Should for any reason a Competitor require a replacement Official Pass a replacement fee of \$30 (GST inclusive) will apply. A replacement Official Pass can only be issued from Saturday to Friday during normal Office hours between 9am & 5pm

Further Competitor Identification is required with the placement, in a prominent position, of the Competitor's Number Sticker on the vehicle being used throughout the Expo. This requirement applies to all Competitors associated with that vehicle and is not limited to the owner and/or driver of the vehicle. All boats are to have the Skipper's Competition Number Sticker attached in a prominent position. Failure to have the competitor sticker affixed prominently, will lead to the disqualification of the Competitor or Competitors associated with the vehicle or boat from the Fishing Competition and the Random and Major Prize Promotional Games.

ASSOCIATE ENTRY: Associates are required to complete the entry form in the manner specified on the form itself and enclose 1 passport sized photograph. If no passport photos are available, photo/s can be obtained at the Expo office on Fraser Island when entering. The Associate entry fee is \$70 (GST inclusive). Should for any reason an Associate require a replacement Associate Pass a replacement fee of \$15 (GST inclusive) will apply. A replacement Associate Pass can only be issued from Saturday to Friday during normal Office hours between 9am & 5pm.

ENTRY PAYMENT: A Competitor or Associate Entry will not be deemed to be accepted until such time that funds tendered (eg. cheque or money order) are cleared in the normal course of banking. If a cheque or money order is dishonoured for any reason whatsoever the Competitor or Associate is responsible for reimbursement of any banking fees incurred by TMCA. A bank cheque inclusive of any banking fees incurred will be required as payment for any cheque or money order dishonoured. Likewise payments made by credit card will not be deemed to be accepted until the placement has been processed, approved and paid. An application for entry will be deemed void where payment is not accepted. A new application for entry will be required. Payment by credit card will show as a deduction on your credit card statement from Toyota Motor Corporation Australia.

CANCELLATION: (a) All nominees will receive a refund of entry fees in the event of cancellation of the whole competition. (b) Money will not be refunded if a Competitor cancels within 21 days prior to the start of the competition. (c) A cancellation fee of \$30 will apply when cancellation occurs 22 days or more from the start of the competition. (d) Competitor Entry is not transferable and cannot be cancelled after 4pm on the Saturday of the Official Opening of the Expo. (e) The Management reserves the right to postpone or cancel in its entirety the Fishing Competition and the Random and Major Promotional Games or both for any reason whatsoever after the Official Opening of the Expo without refund of any monies in total or in part or compensation of any kind.

THE FISHING COMPETITION: The competition consists of two categories: the first being Catch Weigh & Release (Live Fish), the second being Catch & Weigh (Non-Live).

CATCH WEIGH & RELEASE: (a) Prizes will be awarded in this category for the following species, Bream, Flathead, Tarwhine, Sand Whiting and Swallowtail. (b) Only 3 fish of each species will be accepted at each weigh in per Competitor. (c) Any live fish kept for weigh-in must be held in a container above the high water mark. (d) Fish that are mistreated or are deemed unfit for survival will not be accepted. (e) A fish accepted for entry into the Catch Weigh & Release category cannot under any circumstances whatsoever be subsequently entered into the Catch & Weigh category. (f) Daily fish prizes will be decided by (1) Daily Heaviest & (2) Mystery Weight in each species in this category. (g) Daily Prizes: In the event of a tie in any species in this category the first fish weighed in will be deemed the winner. (h) Daily winners not on hand to receive their prize must collect their prize from the Expo office by 10am on Saturday. Prizes not collected by this time will be forfeited to TMCA.

CATCH WEIGH & RELEASE (Live Fish) WEIGH-IN TIMES: From Sunday to Thursday live fish weigh-ins will be held at Waddy Point from 8:30 am to 10am & 1pm to 4pm. On Friday being the final day of competition, live fish weigh-in will only be conducted from 8:30 am to 10 am.

CATCH & WEIGH: (a) Prizes will be awarded in this category for the following species: Jewfish, Job Fish, Red Emperor, Spangled Emperor, Swallowtail, Sweetlip, Tailor, Wahoo/Spanish Mackerel (one category) and Venus Tusk Fish. (b) Only 3 fish of each species will be accepted at each weigh in per Competitor. (c) In this category, fish that are deemed unfit for human consumption will not be eligible for the competition. (d) Daily fish prizes will be decided by the Heaviest Weight in each species in this section. (e) Daily Prizes: In the event of a tie in any species in this category the first fish weighed in will be deemed the winner. (f) Daily winners not on hand to receive their prize must collect their prize from the Expo office by 10am on Saturday. Prizes not collected by this time will be forfeited to TMCA.

CATCH & WEIGH (Non-Live) WEIGH-IN TIMES: From Sunday to Thursday, non-live fish weigh-ins will be conducted from 3.00pm to 5.30pm daily at the Expo site stage area. On Friday, being the final day of competition, non-live weigh-in will only be held between 11am and 1.00pm.

WEIGH-IN GENERAL: (a) Any fish presented at a weigh-in, (Live or Non-Live), which, in the opinion of the judge, was caught more than 25 hours previously will not be accepted. The Judge's opinion is final and Competitors have no right of appeal. (b) Fish caught from one trip to sea cannot be split over two weigh-in periods, and must be weighed in at the 3.00 pm to 5.30pm Sunday to Thursday weigh-ins or 11.00am to 1.00pm on Friday weigh-in.

FISH GENERAL: It is a condition of entry that: (a) All Competitors must fish from the shores of Fraser Island or depart from and return to the shores of Fraser Island daily to be eligible to compete in the Fishing Competition. (b) Fish presented to the scales must be caught in the waters surrounding Fraser Island (apart from the Prohibited/Illegal Fishing and/or Camping Zones. See this heading below), be whole, taken on rod and reel or hand line and must conform to the competitions specified sizes to be eligible for weigh-in. Specified minimum sizes are:

Bream Min 25cm, Whiting Min 23cm, all Flathead Min 40cm-Max 70cm, Swallowtail Min 30cm, Spangled Emperor Min 50cm, Tailor Min 35cm, Tarwhine Min 25cm, Job Fish Min 50cm.

(c) Any change in State or Federal Legislation on fish size and catch numbers will automatically be adopted and must be adhered to by all Competitors. (d) At the Judge's discretion a mutilated fish may not be accepted. (e) All fish presented for weigh-in may be held for an unspecified time by TMCA. (f) All live fish presented and accepted for weigh-in are to be released by TMCA representatives. (g) If any fish is returned to the Competitor who caught the fish, TMCA does not accept any responsibility for a change in condition. (h) Fish caught by any Competitor (including professionals) during the competition may not be sold or offered for sale. (i) All fish may be iced down after being caught, but not frozen. (j) All fish must be weighed-in within 25 hours of being caught.

PROHIBITED/ILLEGAL FISHING and/or CAMPING ZONES: (a) All Mackerel cannot be caught, taken or weighed-in if they come from the western seaboard of Fraser Island. State Law forbids catching Spanish Mackerel between Rooney Point to Coongul Point because of suspect Ciguatera Poison. (b) The Prohibited/Illegal Fishing Zone for the competition is extended from the area of Sandy Cape down the western seaboard of Fraser Island and around to Hook Point. (c) Should any Boating and Fisheries Patrol boat or any appointed competition boat with a Patrol Officer or delegated representative of TMCA on board find any Competitors in possession of Spanish Mackerel in the area of Sandy Cape down the western seaboard and around to Hook Point and west to the mainland, then that Competitor or Competitors will be deemed ineligible to continue and shall be disqualified from the Fishing Competition and the Random and Major Prize Promotional Games without entry fee refund or refunds. (d) During the competition, fishing and/or camping are prohibited northwards from the beginning of South Ngkala Rocks, around Sandy Cape, and southwards around Rooney Point to Bowal Creek, including the beach, estuaries, Wathumba and 500 metres seaward of the beach. (The Prohibited/Illegal Zone), and no boats are to be launched or retrieved in this Zone. (e) Within the Great Sandy Marine Park, fishing may not take place in any Marine Park Green zone which prohibits fishing eg Champagne Pools and Middle Rock as gazetted by State Legislation. (f) Fishing in any of these waters will cause disqualification from the Fishing Competition and the Random and Major Prize Promotional Games. (g) Competitors will not be permitted to camp at Central Station, Lake McKenzie, Lake Boomanjin, Ungawa, Lake Allom, camping areas north of South Ngkala Rocks, camping areas north of Wathumba Creek or Wathumba Creek.

BOAT COMPETITORS: Boat Fishing Times:

Boat Competitors may fish from 5.30am until 4.00pm on each day of the competition except Friday when competition finishes at 1pm. All boats must return to the shores of Fraser Island daily.

Boating General & Safety Requirements: (a) Maritime Safety Queensland will conduct a Marine Safety Centre at Waddy Point for the duration of the Expo. All Competitors are expected to make use of this service. (b) All vessels must have current Queensland registration or registration recognised in Queensland and must have the registration numbers displayed on both sides of the vessel. (c) Boat skippers must be the holder of a Recreational Marine Driver's Licence or a boat licence recognised in Queensland. (d) All vessels must carry all the safety equipment as required by the Queensland Marine Regulations. (e) In the interest of safety it is mandatory that all offshore boats be outfitted with marine radios and an EPIRB (Emergency Position Indicating Radio Beacon). (f) Any vessel deemed by the Official Judge or Acting Official Judge to have an unreasonable advantage over the other Competitors' vessels due to weather conditions or for any other reason will be excluded from the competition for each day the unreasonable advantage exists. (g) It is mandatory that all boats log on and log off with Waddy Point Radio Base each trip they put to sea. Boat based fish prizes will not be awarded to competitors if the boat they have fished from has not logged on and logged off with Waddy Point Radio Base providing the name and a description of the boat and with all Competitor numbers on board. (h) A Skipper's Briefing will be conducted on Saturday at 1500 hours in the area adjacent to the Marine Safety Centre at Waddy Point Base. (i) The Marine Safety Centre will display a flag to advise on fishing conditions of the day. Green – open, Yellow – restricted check with Waddy Point Base, & Red – Closed. Fish caught outside these parameters will not be accepted into the competition. (j) All boats must have the Skipper's Competition Number sticker attached in a prominent position. (See Identification)

PROFESSIONALS: All professional fishermen are eligible for entry into the competition provided: (a) They enter the competition as a recreational fisher. (b) Amateur bag limits are adhered to. (c) They agree to and will not sell any product caught during the competition and not weighed in. Important Notice: Any infringement will result in the exclusion of the commercial fisher/s involved from the competition and possible future competitions. (d) Competitors may not fish from a vessel commercially registered as a charter vessel. (e) PAYG: Pay As You Go withholding tax will not be withheld from any prizes awarded on the basis that the entrant's participation in this event is done so in their private capacity, or as their hobby, unless otherwise notified.

COMPETITION FINISH: Competitors must be in the queue for the Catch Weigh & Release (live fish) weigh-in no later than 10:00 am on Friday or in the queue for the Catch and Weigh, (non-live) weigh-in no later than 1pm on Friday to be eligible to win any fish prize. Once the respective Judge has deemed the queue closed no further competitors will be accepted.

WEEKLY FISHING PRIZES: First Prize: In the event of a tie for first prize the first fish weighed in will be deemed the winner of the cash prize. The next fish weighed in of equal weight will receive second prize. Second Prize: Providing there is no tie for first prize the first fish weighed in will be deemed the winner. The next fish weighed in of equal weight will receive third prize. Third Prize: Providing there is no tie or ties for first or second prizes or both the first fish weighed in will be deemed the winner.

TROPHY PRESENTATION: (a) Will be held at the Expo site and entertainment area from 4.30pm on Friday. (b) Prizes are not transferable and cannot be exchanged for cash. (c) Winners must make their own way to and from the point of presentation of the prizes to collect their prizes. (d) Any unclaimed prizes must be collected by 10am Saturday from the Expo site office. Prizes not collected by this time will be forfeited to TMCA. (e) The value of all prizes stated is at recommended retail price. (f) Any change in the value of the prizes between the publishing date and the date the prizes are claimed is not the responsibility of the promoter

DISQUALIFICATION:

Without limiting any other clause of these terms and conditions, a Competitor will be immediately disqualified from the Fishing Competition and the Random and Major Prize Promotional Games with no monies being refundable and all prizes (if any) forfeited in the following circumstances:

Any Competitor found to be fishing in the Prohibited/Illegal Fishing and/or Camping Zones or any area declared by State or Federal Law as a no fishing area. Competitors are referred to the Terms & Conditions clearly set out under Prohibited/Illegal Fishing and/or Camping Zones above.

Fraud (as described below) and Competitors found to have engaged in any fraudulent activity.

Any Competitor receiving an infringement notice from the Queensland Parks and Wildlife in regard to an infringement of an environmental nature whilst on Fraser Island or travelling to or from Fraser Island for the purpose of attending the Toyota Fraser Island Fishing Expo.

Any Competitor receiving an infringement notice from a Department of Primary Industries and Fisheries Officer for having in their possession undersize fish or fish in excess of the Bag Limit whilst on Fraser Island or travelling to or from Fraser Island for the purpose of attending the Toyota Fraser Island Fishing Expo.

Any Competitor engaging in behaviour that TMCA's Regional Manager Northern Region or his delegated representative deem to be unacceptable whilst on Fraser Island or travelling to or from Fraser Island for the purpose of attending the Toyota Fraser Island Fishing Expo. Note: Unacceptable behaviour by an Associate or Associates will, at the discretion of the Regional Manager Northern Region or his delegated representative of TMCA result in that person or persons being refused entry to the Expo Site and entertainment area.

Refusal to accept the medical advice of the event doctor. If in the reasonable opinion of the event doctor, a Competitor or associate is deemed unfit to continue as a Competitor in the Fishing Expo they will be removed from the competition until such time as they are declared fit by the event doctor. The event doctor is independent and not an employee of TMCA and their decision is final.

Failure to comply with any of the Fishing Competition or the Random and Major Prize Promotional Games terms and conditions

When a Competitor is disqualified from the Fishing Competition for any reason whatsoever they are in turn automatically disqualified from participation in both the Random & Major Prize Promotional Games.

FRAUD: Any evidence of fraud including but not limited to weighing in a fish more than 25 hours since being caught, foreign matter pushed down the mouth of the fish, fish transported from shores other than the shores or offshore waters of Fraser Island, more than one person fishing for each individual entry, netted fish, or any action in deliberate defiance of the rules and goodwill of the competition will result in disqualification as above with the matter being referred to police.

GENERAL CONDITIONS: (a) Any decision of the Management, (TMCA's Regional Manager Northern Region or his delegated representative) is final and TMCA retains the right to withhold any cash prizes, prizes or trophies pending investigation. (b) Management has the right to exclude any person from the competition without giving any reason whatsoever. (c) The Competitor acknowledges that TMCA accepts no liability for any injury, loss or damage suffered by any person in the course of the competition, whether such injury or loss is due or alleged to be due to any act, neglect or default of TMCA or of any representative or agency thereof, and all Competitors fully understand that in so participating they do so entirely at their own risk and agree to abide by all rules and regulations. (d) All Competitors agree to be bound by the Competition Rules as stated in these Terms and Conditions. (e) The Management reserves the right to postpone the fishing time prior to or during the Expo for any section of the trophy category. (f) Any action, incident, or situation not covered by the terms and conditions written in this brochure shall be determined co-jointly by the Official Judge or Acting Official Judge of the Competition and TMCA's Regional Manager Northern Region (or his delegated representative) if or when those conditions arise. The judge's decision concerning all matters related to the competition is final and binding on every Competitor. (g) All entry and application forms remain the property of TMCA Should a Competitor wish to view and/or change their personal particulars they should do so by consulting with the Office Manager at the Expo site. (h) Any supplies made will not be subject to PAYG Withholding Tax on the basis that you have entered this competition in your private capacity or as a hobby.

RANDOM & MAJOR PRIZE PROMOTIONAL GAMES (Terms and Conditions)

The promoter of the Random and Major Prize Promotional Games is Toyota Motor Corporation Australia Ltd ABN 64 009 686 097, (TMCA).

Please note that should a Competitor be disqualified from the Toyota Fraser Island Fishing Expo for any reason whatsoever than that Competitor is also disqualified from both the Random and Major Prize Promotional Games.

TMCA and its agencies and companies associated with this promotion will not be liable for any loss (including but not limited to indirect or consequential loss), damage or personal injury which is suffered or sustained (including without limitation to that caused by any person's negligence) relating to this competition or the awarding or taking of the prizes except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law (in which case liability is limited to the minimum amount allowable by law).

The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any tax implications that may arise from winning of the prizes. Independent financial advice should be sought.

RANDOM DRAWS: There will be a number of random prize draws each night. Each competitors number is eligible to be drawn from the random number generator (a) Once properly registered in the competition the Competitor is automatically placed into a promotional game free of charge that allows the Competitor a chance of winning prizes throughout the week. (d) A redraw will occur if the Competitor whose number has been called does not stop the Countdown Timer within the required time and/or fails to immediately produce their Official Pass (Photographic Identification Pass). (e) Entries must be submitted and paid for by 4pm on the day prior to the Official Opening to be eligible for the Random Draws at the Official Opening. (f) Each Competitor will be eligible to win only one dinghy, or only one of any other prize or prizes nominated by TMCA management or their representative in the Random Draw section for the duration of the competition (g) A full list of all prizes and recommended retail prices is available for inspection at the Expo site office (h) If a prize, or an element of a prize, is unavailable for any reason, the Promoter reserves the right to substitute another prize of equal or greater value for that prize, or element of it, subject to the approval of any relevant authority.

(b) The Competitor, having stopped the Countdown Timer within the timeframe, must immediately present his or her Official Pass (Photographic Identification Pass) to the TMCA representative as proof of identity before proceeding on stage. (c) If the Competitor whose number has been called does not stop the Countdown Timer within the required time and/or fails to immediately produce their Official Pass (Photographic Identification Pass), then a re-draw will occur. (d) Entries must be submitted and paid for by 4pm on the day prior to the Official Opening to be eligible for the Major Draws at the Official Opening. (e) Each Competitor will be eligible to win only one place in the Major Draw. (f) Major Prize will be a Toyota HiLux 4x4 Dual Cab Petrol Manual SR valued at \$2,841 on the road (g) If a prize, or an element of a prize, is unavailable for any reason, the Promoter reserves the right to substitute another prize of equal or greater value for that prize, or element of it, subject to the approval of any relevant authority.

MAJOR DRAW PROCESS: (a) 15 Competitor Numbers will be drawn at the Official Opening and 5 Competitor numbers will be drawn each ensuing night until Friday when 40 numbers in total will have been drawn over the six nights. An additional 10 Competitor numbers will also be drawn on Friday at 4.30pm SHARP to make a total of 50 eligible Competitors. (d) The 50 eligible numbers will be placed in the major prize barrel. These numbers shall be drawn consecutively 1 to 50 and placed in containers numbered 1 to 50, which will correspond to a prize. (h) A full list of the prizes and recommended retail values is available for inspection at the Expo site office.
