Prize Details	<p>The Participant who takes the most catches at each test match will receive the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - \$1,000 for their Club <p>The Participant who takes the least catches at each test match will receive the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - \$500 for their Club <p>Total prize value for all Participants will be transferred directly to the bank account, nominated by the Club</p>
Total Prize Pool	Total Prize Pool: \$4,500 exclusive of GST.
Notification of Winners	All Winners will be notified in person at the Good for Cricket Club Day of their total Prize. Winners' details will also be published as per the Publication Details section.
Publication Details	Details of Winners, including full Club name, Club location and total winnings will be published on Toyota.com.au/news on Friday 11 th January, 2019.
Prize Claim Date	Winner will receive their Prize by Friday 18 th January 2019, by direct bank transfer into the nominated bank account. Conditions of Entry

1. Instructions and information on how to enter form part of these Conditions of Entry. Participation in this Promotion constitutes acceptance of these Conditions of Entry (and Schedule).
2. Any capitalised terms used in these Conditions of Entry have the meaning given in the Schedule, unless stated otherwise.
3. The Promotion will be conducted during the Promotion Period.
4. Eligibility to enter the Promotion is subject to the Entry Restrictions.
5. To enter the Promotion, entrants must complete the Entry Procedure and comply with all other applicable requirements during the Promotion Period. Entries must be submitted in accordance with the Entry Procedure and will not be accepted in any other form. No responsibility is accepted by the Promoter for late, lost, misdirected, ineligible or illegible/inaudible entries (including lost, stolen, forged, defaced or damaged proof of entry or things required by the Verification Requirements). The Promoter and/or its representatives may conduct security and/or verification checks (including enforcement of the Verification Requirements) in their absolute discretion to determine the bona fides of an entrant's eligibility to enter the Promotion. Ineligible entries will be deemed to be invalid.
6. The Promoter's decisions in connection with the Promotion are final and no correspondence will be entered into.
7. All entries and the content contained in those entries become the property of the Promoter. Once submitted, no changes to or withdrawal of an entry will be permitted.
8. Entrants are required to take full responsibility for the content of their entry and for ensuring that their entry complies with these Conditions of Entry. For the purposes of these content requirements, "entry content" includes any content (including text, photos, videos and email messages) that entrants submit, upload, transmit, publish, communicate or use in connection with their entry into the Promotion.
9. Incomplete entries will be deemed invalid. Entries will also be deemed invalid if they breach these Conditions of Entry as determined by the Promoter in its sole discretion or any other content guidelines notified by the Promoter during the entry process for the Promotion.
10. Entries must be the entrant's original work. The Promoter reserves the right to verify, or to require the entrant to verify, that the entry is the entrant's original work. If an entry cannot be verified to the Promoter's satisfaction, the entry will be deemed invalid.

information to other parties, including Australian Cricket's third party service providers. From time to time, these third parties may be located (and so your personal information may be disclosed) overseas, including in India, the USA and the UK, and other countries from time to time. Australian Cricket may use and disclose your personal information for direct marketing purposes, unless you opt out (which you can do at any time in accordance with Australian Cricket's Privacy Policy), and for facilitating further offers directly from third parties if you opt in to receive those offers.
